- Focusing efforts and resources on preventing Environmental incidents, and maintaining emergency response plans. In the event of a contaminant release, CCL will respond promptly in a manner which protects employee and public health and safety, and which mitigates environmental impact. A quarterly report of all incidents will be provided to management and the Board of Directors.
- Quarterly reporting of Health and Safety performance statistics to management and the Board of Directors with the objective of an injury free work place and appropriate responses to all incidents.
- Environmental due diligence will be performed prior to acquisition of all new businesses.
